Big shade trees deliver a suite of environmental benefits. A handful of reasons to plant trees begins with the most obvious. Red Oak (*Quercus rubra*) is an adaptable North American native tree that thrives in diverse landscape settings across the continent.

This fast growing, broad headed, long-lived tree is resistant to Verticillium wilt, heat and drought, air pollution, varied soils and other urban challenges. Its rich, dark green leaves turn dark red in autumn.

American Beech (*Fagus grandifolia*) is a stately North American native tree that's a perfect choice for parks, campuses and boulevards. Smooth, light grey bark begs to be stroked. Large dark green leaves turn bronze-gold in autumn, persisting through the winter months in milder climates. Edible nuts are favored by wildlife.



Urban Sunset® Maple (*A. truncatum* x *A. plat.* 'JFS-KW187' PP 27545) is a vigorous, upright growing, narrow tree that calipers well and develops a compact, uniformly branched canopy with minimal pruning. Dark green leaves are glossy and tatter-resistant. Rich, deep red fall color is bright and long lasting.
