

Ninebarks rise and shine as small trees



Coppertina® Ninebark

Ninebarks are wonderfully versatile and adaptable North American native shrubs found throughout eastern North America. These hardy, hearty natives have given rise (literally) to the tough and adaptable garden cultivars that that we grow as tree forms.



Raised on a standard, our Coppertina® and Summer Wine® cultivars thrive as small trees with sturdy trunks that feature handsome, two-tone exfoliating bark. They lend a formal, topiary-like look to gardens and containers.

Pest free and tolerant of drought and acid or alkaline soils, they are tough plants for home or commercial landscapes.

Coppertina® Ninebark (*P. opulifolius* 'Mindia' PP16,371) has orange-copper foliage in spring that matures to rich red. White, button-like blooms create a striking contrast. Bright reddish-orange fall color is complemented by striking red seed capsules. A hybrid of 'Dart's Gold' and 'Diabolo'.

Summer Wine® Ninebark (*P. opulifolius* 'Seward' PP14,821) has wine colored foliage that plays well with the button-like, pink-tinted, white flowers of spring. A hybrid of 'Nana' and 'Diabolo', it matures at about half their size.
