Make a point by purchasing our new columnar trees – before they're gone! Spears, sentinels, beacons, javelins, pinnacles, pillars, rockets, colonnades, obelisks, sentries and spires appear on this first stock available of

the season. But they're going fast, thanks to a growing demand for narrow trees that fit into restricted planting spaces. Brand new to the marketplace, these three narrow beauties join our lineup of columnar classics.



Ivory Spear™ Crabapple

As implied by its name, a narrow column of fragrant white flowers juts skyward in spring. They emerge from deep pink buds that cluster along the stiffly upright branches of this unique new ornamental crabapple. Flowers are followed by a uniform column of dark green leaves that remain clean and disease-free throughout the summer months. Bright, cherry red fruits of about ½" diameter add bright contrast when they appear among the leaves in late summer, which turn yellow in autumn. A height and spread of 18' x 7' assures its suitability for tight growing spaces.



Raspberry Spear™ Crabapple

Deep pink buds are thrust skyward in spring by the stiffly upright branches of this new columnar crabapple. Bright magenta flowers are followed by deep purple, clean and disease-free foliage that holds its dark color long into the summer months. Older foliage presents bronze tones in late summer and early fall, when orange tints appear. Purple-red, ½" fruits ripen to deep bright red and persist into early winter. Mature height and spread is 20' x 8'.



Saffron Sentinel™ Cornelian Cherry

Bright yellow flowers bursting from buds clustered along its winter-bare branches herald the beginning of spring. This remarkably columnar selection of Cornelian Cherry Dogwood is vigorous, symmetrical, and resistant to pests and diseases. Foliage remains clean and dark green throughout the summer months. Bright red oval fruits that ripen in late summer are tart and tasty. Dark brown bark that exfoliates with age complements the deep crimson fall color and adds winter interest. Height and spread is approximately 22' x 12'.
