

Pink Pom Poms Redbud

Cercis canadensis 'Pink Pom Poms' P.A.F.

Vivid pink, double-petaled flowers crowd the upright branches of Pink Pom Poms Redbud. Borne in dense clusters, they present a particularly bright display of bloom along the limbs of this vigorous and symmetrical tree. Emerging about a week later than is typical of the species, the flowers are sterile and do not set seed pods.

Thanks to its Oklahoma Redbud heritage, its heart-shaped green leaves are slightly glossy, and turn to rich yellow in autumn. Height and spread of this USDA Zone 6b tree are approximately 20' x 15'. Dr. Dennis Werner of North Carolina State University developed this unique hybrid by crossing the double-flowered "Flame" Redbud with heat and drought tolerant Oklahoma Redbud.
