Paperbark Maples have wide ranging appeal

Paperbark Maple (*Acer griseum*) is a popular small shade tree that's proving to be street tough. A garden and landscape favorite for generations, this sturdy, adaptable, drought tolerant beauty has taken to the streets in communities across the continent. Typically grown as a multi-stem garden tree, it is a compact, adaptable, ornamental street tree when trained as a single stem specimen.

Striking, silky-smooth cinnamon brown bark exfoliates in paper-thin curls. Refined, dark green leaves in clusters of three appear delicate, but are remarkably resistant to pests and disease as well as being drought and heat tolerant. Come autumn, they glow red late in the season when most maples have defoliated.

Fireburst™ Paperbark Maple (*Acer griseum* 'JFS-KW8AGRI') is a new cultivar that brings predictable performance and consistent form to an already popular, but highly variable species. Superior branch structure, upright form, speedy growth, and predictable performance are reasons to choose this cultivar over seedling-grown trees.

Named for its brilliant fall color, the dark green summer leaves of Fireburst™ Paperbark Maple explode into long-lasting shades of bright red that bring visual warmth to the chilly days of autumn. Smooth, cinnamon brown bark unfurls in exfoliating papery curls to provide year-round interest.
