



# JAVELIN<sup>®</sup>

FLOWERING PEAR

*Pyrus 'NCPX1' PP26542*

Javelin<sup>®</sup> Pear is a perfect fit for streetscapes and space-challenged landscapes. A strong central leader and upright branches with open angles promise ease of care in the nursery and storm resistance in the landscape. Javelin<sup>®</sup> stays narrow as it matures and is a perfect fit for alleés, visual screens and streetside plantings.

Dense clusters of pink-tinged white blooms smother the branches of this landscape exclamation point in spring. Leaves soon emerge maroon-purple and gradually mature to glossy dark green. Insect and disease-resistant foliage stays fresh through the heat of summer and turns purple to maroon in autumn.

Developed at North Carolina State University by Dr. Tom Ranney, this ornamental pear combines the best characteristics of its parents; inheriting urban adaptability and superior fireblight resistance from 'Cleveland Select' Pear, and fastigiate form and distinctive red flower buds from x *Pyrus pyrifolia* 'Ohara Beni'.
