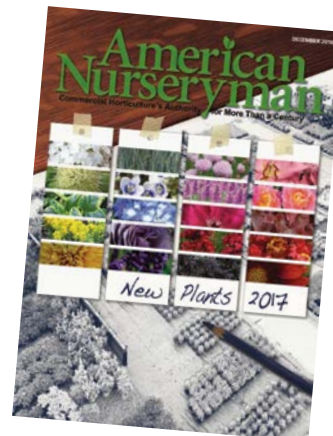


Our trees rise and shine among New Plants for 2017

Our trees stand tall amid the 86 New Plants for 2017 presented in the December issue of American Nurseryman. Readers can't help but take notice of our two trees, as 83 of those new intros are annuals, perennials, shrubs or grasses.



Urban Sunset® Maple is a drought and heat tolerant hybrid maple with deep green leaves that turn fiery red in autumn. Adaptable to poor soils and urban growing conditions, it develops a relatively narrow canopy with a minimum of pruning.

Mercury™ Magnolia is a traffic-stopping tree that sports enchanting lavender-pink blooms in spring. It presents lush, deeply textured, tropical-looking dark green leaves throughout the growing season. Developed at North Carolina State University by Dr. Tom Ranney, Mercury™ Magnolia has

proven to be heat tolerant and adaptable. Its late-season bloom time greatly reduces the risk of frost damage that's common in other *M. soulangeana* selections.
