Cercis canadensis 'UMN7101'

Heart's Desire™ Redbud

Zone: 4 | **Height:** 15' | **Spread:** 20'



Shape: Rounded, spreading

Foliage: Medium green

Fall Color: Yellow

Flower: Lavender pink

Blooming beautifully for more than 40 years in the Minnesota Landscape Arboretum, this time-tested, exceptionally hardy introduction of the University of Minnesota welcomes spring with a profusion of lavender pink blooms. The stunning display of flowers is a welcome sight after the long, dark days of winter.

Acer saccharum 'Whit XLIX' PP 23957

Powder Keg® Maple

Zone: 5 | **Height:** 50' | **Spread:** 40'



Shape: Upright oval becoming rounded

Foliage: Dark green, leathery

Fall Color: Bright orange-red

An explosion of bright fall colors and upright, symmetrical form distinguish this resilient cultivar selected from Caddo sugar maples of western Oklahoma. Adaptability to heat, drought, and tough growing conditions extend far beyond its region of origin.



Hydrangea paniculata 'Renhy' PP 20670

Vanilla Strawberry™ Hydrangea



Zone: 3 | **Height:** 10' | **Spread:** 7'



Shape: Upright oval, rounded with age

Foliage: Medium green

Flower: Creamy white, pink, red

Creamy white blooms mature to pink and then strawberry red. As new flowers emerge, they join the more mature blooms to form a frothy blend of vanilla and strawberry red colors in late summer and early fall. Cone-shaped flower heads are excellent for fresh and dried arrangements.



An extensive selection, breeding and testing program is key to our successful introduction of more than 100 unique trees to the marketplace. New introductions may be the product of our own breeding and selection programs, or as co-introductions with others who bring their unique discoveries to us for testing and introduction. Prunus sargentii 'JFS KW21PS'
Pink Myst™ Cherry

Zone: 4 | Height: 30' | Spread: 15'



Shape: Upright to upright oval
Foliage: Dark green
Fall Color: Orange to orange red
Flower: Deep pink

Bright pink flowers, darker in color than other Sargent Cherry blooms, smother the branches of this unique cultivar. Rich, dark green summer foliage turns to lovely shades of orange and red in autumn. It is also narrower and more upright in form than is typical of the species.



Hibiscus syriacus 'Notwoodthree' PP 20574
Blue Chiffon® Rose of Sharon



Zone: 5 | Height: 12' | Spread: 8'



Shape: Upright oval, rounded with age
Foliage: Green
Flower: Blue

Blue blooms with ruffled centers brighten the landscape with a continuous parade of cool color from mid-summer to late fall. Vigorous growth and adaptability to varied soils, heat and drought make this diminutive tree a great choice for patios and small space gardens.

Hibiscus syriacus 'Notwoodone' PP 12619
Lavender Chiffon® Rose of Sharon



Zone: 5 | Height: 12' | Spread: 8'



Shape: Upright oval, rounded with age
Foliage: Green
Flower: Lavender

Large, frilly lavender flowers provide bright color throughout the summer months while attracting butterflies, hummingbirds and other pollinators. Grown as a small tree, this colorful cultivar is tolerant of heat and varied soils.



Hibiscus syriacus 'Jwnwood4' PP 24336
Pink Chiffon® Rose of Sharon



Zone: 5 | Height: 12' | Spread: 8'



Shape: Upright oval, rounded with age
Foliage: Green
Flower: Pink, double

This small tree packs a lot of flower power, thanks to its elegant, clear pink double blooms that appear throughout the summer months. Excellent specimen or background plant, perfect for patios and small space gardens.

White Chiffon® Rose of Sharon




Zone: 5 | Height: 12' | Spread: 8'



Shape: Upright oval, rounded with age
Foliage: Green
Flower: White

Large white flowers, embellished with ruffled edges and fluffy centers, bloom throughout the summer months. The perfect choice for moonlight gardens where these small, flower laden trees lend a luminous glow to evening strolls.





Ginkgo biloba 'Blagon'

Goldspire Ginkgo

Zone: 4 | **Height:** 45' | **Spread:** 12'



Shape: Narrowly columnar
Foliage: Green
Fall Color: Bright golden yellow
Fruit: Seedless

Introduced from France, this densely branched, tightly fastigate cultivar forms a narrow, symmetrical spire at a younger age than is typical of other columnar selections. Leathery, fan-like foliage turns golden yellow in autumn.



Gymnocladus dioica 'Morton'

Skinny Latte™ Kentucky Coffee Tree

Zone: 4 | **Height:** 50' | **Spread:** 18'



Shape: Narrow vase, nearly columnar
Foliage: Green leaflets form large, frond-like fans
Fall Color: Yellow
Fruit: Seedless

Stiffly upright structural branches ascend vertically to form a remarkably narrow canopy and unique winter silhouette. Originating from a seedling acquired by the Morton Arboretum in 1958, the unique selection is an introduction of ChicagolandGrows®.
