## Belle Tower™ Maple



**Zone:** 5  
**Height:** 45'  
**Spread:** 18'  
**Shape:** Narrow oval  
**Foliage:** Bright green  
**Fall Color:** Orange-yellow

Adapted to heat and humidity, this southern Tennessee selection was tested in Alabama by Jeff Sibley of Auburn University. Summer foliage is fresh and bright green compared to other sugar maples that suffer in hot weather. Additionally, it is among the narrowest and upright forms we have seen.

## John Pair Maple



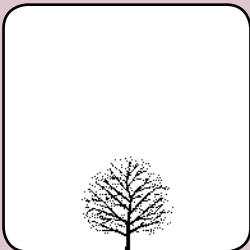
**Zone:** 5  
**Height:** 30'  
**Spread:** 30'  
**Shape:** Rounded  
**Foliage:** Glossy green  
**Fall Color:** Red

Symmetrical and rounded in form, this heat resistant sugar maple of small stature is at home in the southern plains. Selected by horticulturist Dr. John Pair from the heat resistant Caddo County, Oklahoma seed source, its foliage stands up to summer heat.

## Silver Ball™ Pear



**Zone:** 4  
**Height:** 12'  
**Spread:** 12'  
**Shape:** Compact, rounded dwarf  
**Foliage:** Silver-gray  
**Fall Color:** Yellow-orange  
**Flower:** Small, white

This compact dwarf pear features tiny silvery green leaves that give it a fine textured appearance. An introduction by Harold Pellett and the Landscape Plant Development Center, it's the most dwarf pear we grow and has shown strong fireblight resistance.

## Presidential Gold™ Ginkgo



**Zone:** 4  
**Height:** 50'  
**Spread:** 40'  
**Shape:** Broadly pyramidal to oval  
**Foliage:** Medium green  
**Fall Color:** Bright yellow  
**Fruit:** Seedless

Outstanding in both the nursery row and the landscape, this seedless cultivar may set the new standard among Ginkgos. Selected by Dr. Michael Dirr, it has a strong central leader and full branching when young, then develops a dense upright crown when mature.

## Golden Colonnade™ Ginkgo



**Zone:** 4

**Height:** 45'

**Spread:** 25'

**Shape:** Narrow oval

**Foliage:** Medium green

**Fall Color:** Bright yellow

**Fruit:** Seedless

Thanks to its strongly upright central leader and narrowly oval growth habit, this *Ginkgo* discovered by Dr. Michael Dirr is ideal for narrow street use. The original tree has male flowers and is observed to be seedless.

## Rugged Charm™ Maple



**Zone:** 3

**Height:** 20'

**Spread:** 15'

**Shape:** Compact broad oval

**Foliage:** Medium green

**Fall Color:** Yellow-orange to red

**Flowers:** White clusters in May

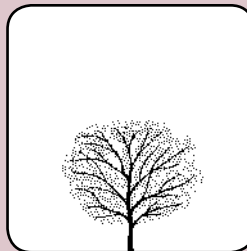
**Fruit:** Attractive red samaras

Compact and oval in form, the shapely canopy of this refined selection is a charming improvement over the hardy and rugged species! Bright red seed wings float in bright contrast against summer's green leaves. Come autumn, the boldly textured foliage shows off a rich mix of yellow, orange, and bright red.

## Beijing Gold® Tree Lilac



**Zone:** 5

**Height:** 20'

**Spread:** 20'

**Shape:** Upright spreading

**Foliage:** Dark green

**Fall Color:** Yellowish

**Flower:** Yellow, in clusters

Sprays of yellow flowers borne in June bring a whole new color spectrum to the world of tree lilacs! This is a vigorous selection with upright spreading, arching branches in a species that matures to a small size.

## Northern Acclaim<sup>®</sup> Honeylocust



**Zone:** 3b  
**Height:** 45'  
**Spread:** 35'  
**Shape:** Broadly pyramidal  
**Foliage:** Fine textured, medium green  
**Fall Color:** Yellow

Selected by Dale Herman at North Dakota State University for its cold hardiness in the rugged environment of the Great Plains. Northern Acclaim<sup>™</sup> develops a more upright shape than most, similar to Skyline<sup>®</sup>.

## Urban Bouquet<sup>™</sup> Ash



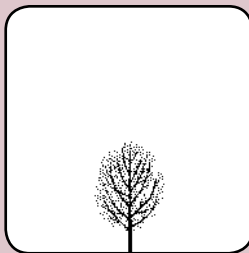
**Zone:** 6  
**Height:** 35'  
**Spread:** 25'  
**Shape:** Oval  
**Foliage:** Medium green  
**Fall Color:** Yellow to purple tinted  
**Flower:** Creamy white, large panicles  
**Fruit:** Seedless

Billowing clouds of creamy white, fragrant panicles cover its branches in May and June. This seedless selection blooms heavily and reliably on an upright oval frame. Suitable for street use and smaller yards, this cultivar adds uniformity to a great urban tree species.

## Jack<sup>®</sup> Pear



**Zone:** 4  
**Height:** 16'  
**Spread:** 10'  
**Shape:** Compact upright oval  
**Foliage:** Dark green  
**Fall Color:** Yellow  
**Flower:** White

Tight and upright in form, this cultivar is ideal for narrow streets and planting beneath utility wires. Its dwarf growth rate results in a cultivar that matures at less than half the size typical of the species. Its density and upright habit give the unusual combination of a formal appearance in a low maintenance tree.

## Heart Throb® Dogwood



**Zone:** 5  
**Height:** 20'  
**Spread:** 20'  
**Shape:** Rounded  
**Foliage:** Dark green  
**Fall Color:** Deep red  
**Flower:** Deep rose pink  
**Fruit:** Red, 3/4"

Large, deep reddish to rose-pink flower bracts form flower heads that reach four inches in diameter. Introduced by Don Schmidt Nursery, its handsome blooms last for up to two months in Oregon.

## White Satin™ Birch

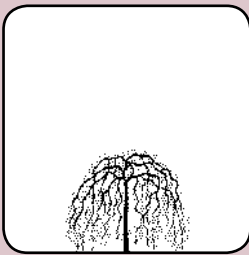


**Zone:** 4  
**Height:** 35'  
**Spread:** 20'  
**Shape:** Broadly pyramidal to oval  
**Foliage:** Dark green  
**Fall Color:** Golden yellow  
**INSECT RESISTANCE:** Reported resistance to bronze birch borer

Selected by Dr. Ed Hasselkus of the University of Wisconsin, the original tree has resisted borers for nearly 30 years while nearby trees have died. Good cold hardiness, golden yellow fall color and satin-white bark are additional features of this long-lived, handsome tree.

## Lavender Twist® Redbud



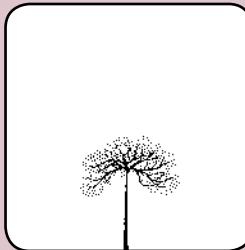
**Zone:** 5  
**Height:** 7'  
**Spread:** 8'  
**Shape:** Weeping, umbrella shaped  
**Foliage:** Medium green  
**Fall Color:** Yellow  
**Flower:** Magenta buds open rosy pink

Elegant and graceful, weeping and compact, this plant creates a great feature in a small garden. Springtime's tight clusters of bright magenta buds open to reveal rosy pink flowers. Slightly zigzagging branches cascade to form lattice work curtains of heart-shaped foliage.

## Gold Tide™ Forsythia



**Zone:** 5  
**Height:** 5'  
**Spread:** 4'  
**Shape:** Horizontal spreading to weeping  
**Foliage:** Medium green  
**Fall Color:** Yellow  
**Flower:** Bright yellow

We grow this dwarf, spreading Forsythia as a top graft, and as such it forms a slightly weeping little patio tree. Compact and graceful, it greets the earliest days of spring with bright yellow flowers.

## Sensation Lilac

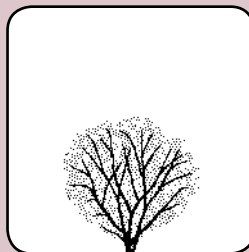


**Zone:** 3  
**Height:** 10'  
**Spread:** 8'  
**Shape:** Upright shrub  
**Foliage:** Medium green  
**Flower:** Purple

Each single purple flower is edged with a white border, giving a silvery-purple appearance from a distance. Sweetly scented.

## Miss Canada Lilac



**Zone:** 2  
**Height:** 7'  
**Spread:** 6'  
**Shape:** Upright rounded shrub  
**Foliage:** Medium green  
**Flower:** Pink

Bright pinkish red buds open to true pink flowers on this late flowering hybrid lilac. Flowers are delicately held in loose sprays, giving a relaxed and graceful appearance. Mildew resistant and reported to be non-suckering.

## Snow Charm® Japanese Snowbell



**Zone:** 5  
**Height:** 20'  
**Spread:** 20'  
**Shape:** Rounded  
**Foliage:** Dark green  
**Fall Color:** Yellowish  
**Flower:** Pure white, bell shaped

Reliable and easy to grow, this Schmidt introduction selected from a highly variable species assures a rounded form. Like Snowcone®, it resists twig dieback, but has larger leaves and a broader, more traditional form.
