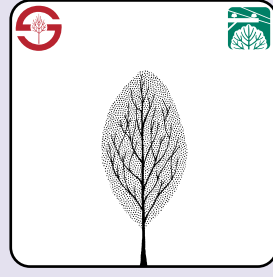

Raspberry Spear® Crabapple
Malus 'JFS KW213MX' PP 31008

Height: 20' | Spread: 8' | Hardiness: -30°F



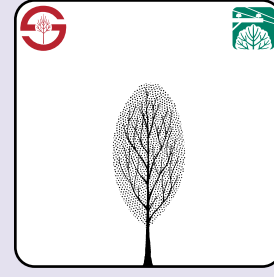
Shape: Narrow upright column
Foliage: Purple
Flower: Magenta pink
Fruit: Maroon to deep red, 1/2", persistent

DISEASE RESISTANCE:
Scab: Excel. **Fireblight:** Excel.
Cedar-Apple Rust: Excel. **Mildew:** Excel.
Deep pink buds open to form a narrow column of bright magenta. Summer foliage holds its purple color into late summer when orange tints herald the advent of autumn. Bright red fruits persist into late autumn or early winter.



Ivory Spear® Crabapple

Height: 18' | Spread: 7' | Hardiness: -30°F



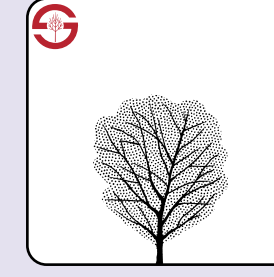
Shape: Narrow, tightly columnar

Fruit: Bright red, 1/2"

Deep pink buds open to form a slender column of pink-tinged white flowers. Clean, dark green leaves set the stage for bright cherry red fruits that persist into late autumn, when a splash of yellow fall color adds seasonal interest.

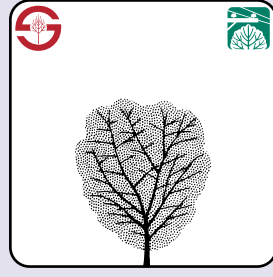

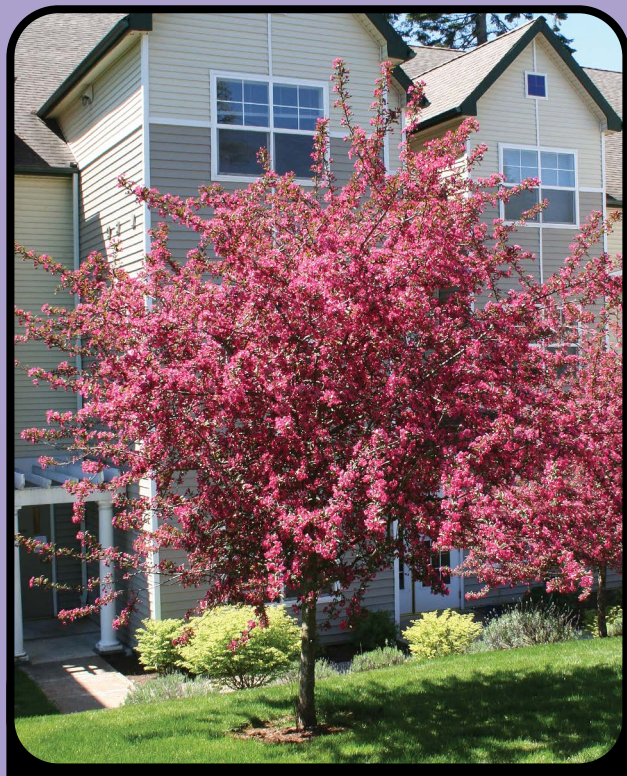
Golden Raindrops® Crabapple

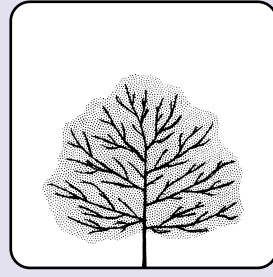

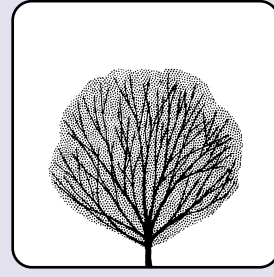

Featuring pure white flowers but no fruit, this is the crabapple to use in locations such as patios and courtyards where fruit would be objectionable. It flowers well on an annual basis.

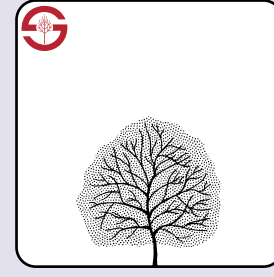

Abundant bright magenta-pink flowers set the stage for exceptionally disease resistant purple red leaves that mature to bronze by late summer and turn orange red in autumn. Deep red fall fruits are tiny and persistent.



Sparkling Sprite® Crabapple

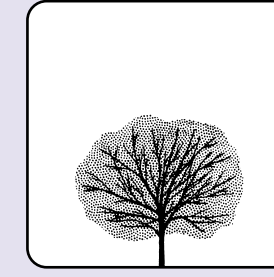

Fruit: Yellow to golden orange, 1/2"

Pink buds open to white flowers that smother the dense, rounded head of this compact dwarf. Foliage is especially clean and bright green. Abundant fruit crop persists into winter, turning gradually from golden yellow to orange.



Coralburst® Crabapple

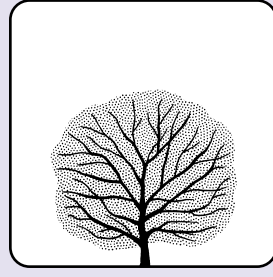

Top grafted on a 4' standard, Coralburst® is slow growing and forms a very dense, symmetrically rounded head; a perfectly formal topiary shape.

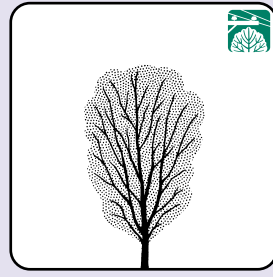

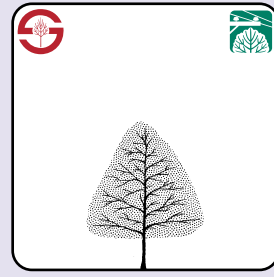

Shape: Pyramidal, compact
Foliage: Dark green
Flower: Single bright white, opening from pink buds
Fruit: Yellow to golden orange, 1/4"

Cedar-Apple Rust: Excel. **Mildew:** Excel.
Bright white flowers smother the branches of this densely branched, symmetrical tree, followed by clean, dark green leaves. Yellow to golden orange fruits take the four-season show into the winter months.



Red Jewel™ Crabapple
Malus 'Jewelcolor'

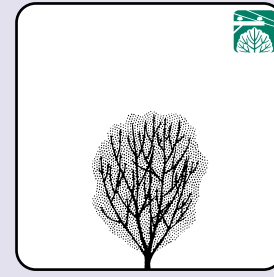

Bright red fruits are among the most profuse and persistent of any crab. They provide food for hungry birds or hold fast until spring in mild winter areas, when they are replaced by an abundance of white blooms.

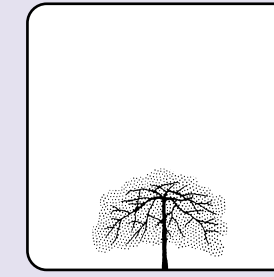

Sargent Tina Crabapple

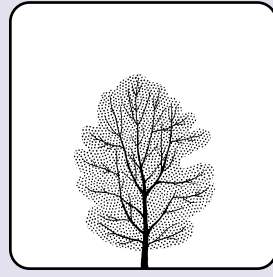

Bright red buds burst into bloom, smothering the branches of this petite, top-grafted tree with fragrant flowers. Tiny, bright red fruits develop amid the clean, green, disease-resistant foliage and persist into the winter months.



Eddie's White Wonder Dogwood
Cornus 'Eddie's White Wonder'

Height: 25' | Spread: 20' | Hardiness: -10°F



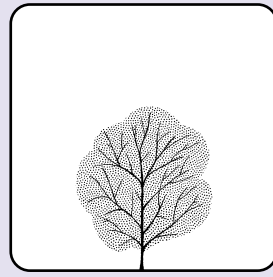
Shape: Upright, pyramidal with slightly pendulous branching

Flower: Large white bracts
Fruit: Small red

White flower bracts of this hybrid cultivar are much larger than those of its parent *C. florida*, and it grows taller. It is also easier to grow and more adaptable than its other parent, *C. nuttallii*.



Scarlet Fire® Dogwood
Cornus 'Rutpink' PP 28311

Height: 20' | Spread: 18' | Hardiness: -20°F



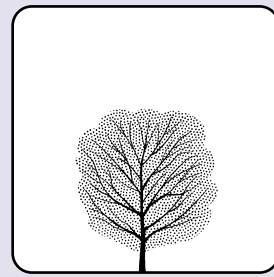
Shape: Broadly oval
Foliage: Dark green
Fall Color: Maroon
Flower: Large bracts, deep pink to fuchsia
Fruit: Red, 1"
Disease Resistance: Dogwood anthracnose and powdery mildew

Dramatic fuchsia-pink blooms float atop dark green foliage in late spring and last for several weeks. Each bloom, formed by pointed bracts that do not overlap, resembles a four-pointed star. Leaves emerge with purple blush.



Venus® Dogwood
Cornus (kousa x nuttallii) 'kousa' 'KN 30-8' PP 16309

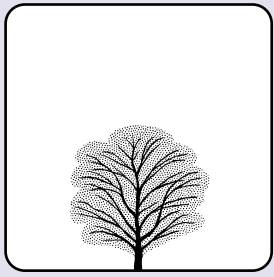

This vigorous hybrid combines the huge flowers of the Pacific dogwood with the environmental tolerance of the Chinese species. Venus® has the largest bloom of any dogwood we have seen and is very floriferous. Little fruit, nearly sterile.



Summer Fun Dogwood
Cornus kousa 'Summer Fun'

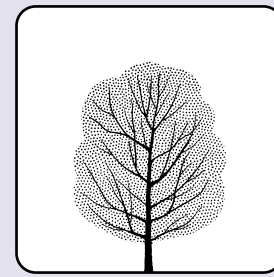

White flower bracts of late spring complement rich, boldly contrasting green and cream-white leaves. Leaf margins are brighter white than those of other variegated dogwoods. Vivid fall tones are red orange and pink.



Starlight® Dogwood
Cornus kousa x nuttallii 'KN4-43' PP 16293

Height: 30' | Spread: 20' | Hardiness: -10°F



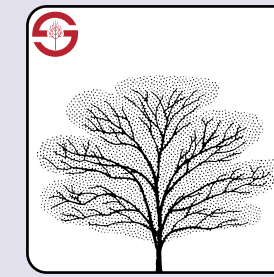

Flower: Large, creamy white
Fruit: Red orange, 1/4" sparse
Disease Resistance: Dogwood anthracnose and powdery mildew

Healthy dark green foliage complements the large, firm, creamy white flower bracts that smother its branches in late spring. This hybrid offers the upright growth habit and form of its Pacific dogwood parent, plus the disease resistance of its Chinese dogwood parent.



June Snow™ Dogwood
Cornus controversa 'June Snow-JFS'

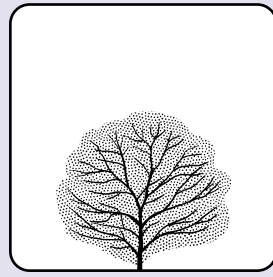
Shape: Horizontally layered, spreading
Foliage: Dark green
Fall Color: Orange to red
Flower: White, in flat topped clusters
Fruit: Blue-black, 1/4", clustered

Fast growing and wide spreading, with branches developing a horizontally tiered appearance. Flat topped clusters of white flowers often exceed 6" in diameter. Outstanding fall color; mottled orange-yellow, red, and purple-red.



Heart Throb® Dogwood
Cornus kousa 'Schmied'

Height: 20' | Spread: 20' | Hardiness: -20°F



Shape: Rounded
Foliage: Dark green
Fall Color: Deep pink
Flower: Rose pink
Fruit: Red, 1/4"

It's love at first sight when rose-pink flowers up to four inches in diameter unfurl in spring and smother the lush green leaves with a blanket of pink blooms. Bright red fruits appear in late summer. Deep red, long-lasting fall color paints a striking picture in autumn.
